WHY MUSIC MATTERS

In Colorado, access to school-day music education is not guaranteed. Many under-resourced schools lack the funding, staffing, instruments, and infrastructure needed to sustain a music program.

Music helps students build confidence, focus, creativity, collaboration, adaptability, and self-expression.

Across the Education Through Music network, reported outcomes include improved attentiveness among 93% of students, stronger math achievement in 98% of schools, and 94% of students feeling that they and their families were more welcome at school.

We place dedicated teachers, equip classrooms, coach educators, and help schools build lasting music programs.

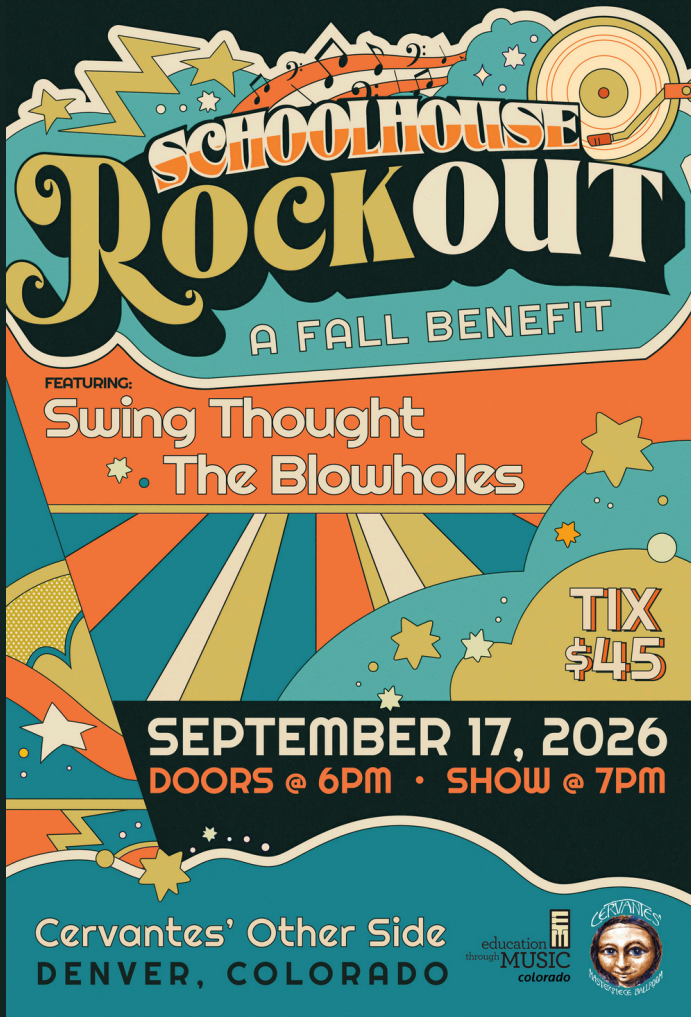
Launched in 2019, ETM-CO is part of the national Education Through Music network, which has served more than 500,000 students since 1991.
